COOL LIPO™

Liquefies fat-1320 wavelength
 1 day-2 weeks compression garment
 < 1% complication rate

Done in office
 Can drive after procedure
 Zero scarring
 Doctor performs treatment
 Can return to work next day
 Mild swelling
 Targets water
 Little to no collateral damage to surrounding tissue
 Can treat ANY skin color safely
 First to introduce 1064 wavelength to aesthetics but would NEVER use it for this procedure
 No stitches
 Dual mode: Tightening Only
 Lipo + Tightening
 2 Fiber sizes: Can treat small and large areas
 320 um & 500um
 Peak Power-4000 Watts (better effect on fat cells)
 Treatment power: 6-15 Watts
 Local anesthesia
 Zero to minimal bruising
 1-2 Days recovery time

SMART LIPO™

Liquefies fat-1064 wavelength
 2 week compression garment
 < 1% complication rate. Can cause hyperpigmentation and burns.

Done in office or hospital outpatient
 Can drive after procedure
 Zero scarring
 Doctor performs treatment
 Can return to work next day
 Mild swelling
 Targets melanin and hemaglobin
 More chance for collateral damage to surrounding tissue
 Can only treat light colored skin safely
 Uses 1064 wavelength
 No stitches
 Only Lipo (relies on collagen remodeling to cause tightening)
 1 Fiber size for smaller areas
 300um
 1500 Watts
 Treatment power: 6 Watts
 Local anesthesia
 Minimal bruising
 1-2 Days recovery time

LIPO DISSOLVE™

Chemicals kill fat cells
 Zero compression garment
 Zero complication rate

Done in office
 Can drive after procedure
 Zero scarring
 No doctor required
 Can return to work immediately
 Swelling

No stitches

Zero anesthesia
 Bruising
 Zero recovery time

LIPOSUCTION

Cannula sucks out fat
 6 week compression garment
 Up to 10% complication rate

Outpatient
 Can't drive after procedure
 Some scarring
 Doctor performs treatment
 4 days-2 weeks no work
 Swelling

Stitches
 Can leave loose and sagging skin

General anesthesia
 Bruising
 1-2 weeks recovery time
